*“A Musical Prayer and Meditation with Dandiya
Dandiya Raas is the traditional folk dance form of
Vrindavan, where it is performed depicting scenes of lila
of Krishna and Radha. The women wear traditional
dresses such as colorful embroidered choli, ghagra and
bandahni dupattas, which is the traditional attire,
dazzling with mirror work and heavy jewellery. The men
wear special turbans and kedias, but can range from area
to area. The dancers whirl and move their feet and arms
in a choreographed manner to the tune of the music with
a lot of drum beats.”*
